Crisis and Urgent Need Giving in 2024

MISSION SAFETY INTERNATIONAL - Tennesse

Since 1983, MSI has helped aviation staff fly safe missions to share the Gospel around the world. From fixing aircraft to improving airstrips, MSI works to improve the safety of mission aviation organizations and pilots. MSI conducted 11 Safet Audits for missions all over the world, provided instruction at 3 Safety Seminars, and presented a



ferences in 2024. There were several accidents requiring MSI's assistance to restore the planes but there were no fatalities.

THE CENTER OF HOPE - Venice Pastors Jim and Lynette McCleland

The Center of Hope is a neighborhood church and outreach center that assists those in need; the homeless, veterans, single-parent families, the elderly, the working



poor. It is one of six entry points in Sarasota County to provide food, clothing, and housing, for the community. This past year they served a record number of families in need. During the hurricane 4,180 people were fed through World Central Kitchen on their property. They lost thousands of dollars in meat during Helene and Milton as their generators could not keep up and fuel was scarce. They are still dealing with families who are displaced, living in hotels and places not meant for habitation. They moved into our new building with a goal to provide a breakfast and hot lunch with a recovery meeting and hot showers.

VENICE CHRISTIAN SCHOOL Principal Jerry Frimmel

VCS is a fully accredited, nondenominational, private Christian school of over 350 students in Pre-K through 12th grade. The school serves



students from Sarasota to Port Charlotte and are representative of more than 45 churches. VCS partners with families, local churches, and the community to educate children in accordance with the truth of Scriptures and to pursue excellence in academic instruction with a Biblical worldview. VCS Student Services serves approximately 100 students providing gifted programming, services for students who are health impaired, have learning disabilities and academic deficits. The demand for a Christ-centered education in our communinty led VCS to expand its facilities. The picture above is the architectural rendering of the new building. Their main parking lot has 50 new parking spots. Your Faith Promise gifts support the expansion that has already begun.

AGANG, Rev. Sunday Bobai

ECWA (Evangelical Church Winning All) Theological Seminary - Nigeria

Rev. Agang serves as President of the Seminary with a call to evangelize the unsaved, teach Christian discipleship, address the issues of minority abuses, exploitation and oppression of orphans, and fostering and nurturing interfaith dialogues between Christians and Muslims in

Nigeria. All amidst increasing acts of kidnapping, banditry and terrorism in Nigeria. His wife, Sarah serves as the Coordinator of the Seminary's Women Institute with an out reach to 600 widows and 400 orphans whose husbands or parents were killed by bandits and terrorists. Their work focuses on trauma training healing, skill acquisition, spiritual and economic empowerment.

Rev. Agang has written extensively on the Gospel in the context of Globalizaiton, Terrorism, Corruption, Persecution, Human Suffering, and more. He is a professor of Christian Theology, Ethics & Public Policy at the ECWA Seminary and is a sought-after speaker around the world. He works in a Muslim-dominated region of Northern Nigeria, where religious violence and other social crises have become unprecedented; including the rise of Islamic terrorists and nomadic Fulani militias. Labeled the poverty capital of the world, people in Nigeria have been devastated by the scourge of unemployment, leaving families traumatized and desperate. Rev. Agang works to educate and train students at the ECWA Seminary to send forth more Christian pastors and leaders in local communities and beyond.

AGAPE FLIGHTS - Venice

Every week, aircraft depart from the Agape Flights hangar in Venice, transporting all kinds of provisions

and mail to hundreds of missionary partners living and working in Haiti, the Dominican Republic and the Bahamas. Their pilots are met at



airports throughout the Caribbean islands by missionaries who serve as the distribution network on the ground. They ensure that supplies reach the orphanages, medical clinics, schools, hospitals, and churches they serve to share the love of Christ. The building supplies become homes, the water pumps provide clean water for entire communities, and the Bibles become resources for discipleship. Agape also expedites relief supplies during disasters and delivers humanitarian aid into Cuba, when possible, and serves as an important stateside connection for missionaries by serving as their "home" address.

Venice Train Depot

Breakfast Church continues on a weekly basis on Friday mornings through the dedicated efforts of 25 + volunteers, including food preparers, transporters, set up and take down people, musicians and speak-



ers. Depending on the day, there are anywhere from 5 to 15 homeless participants. In addition to providing a warm sandwich, fruit, coffee and a take-away lunch, opportunities arise for prayer, spiritual growth and allowing Jesus to enter the hearts of the homeless. Clothing and personal hygiene items are made available as well. By simply showing care and love to the "guests" that participate, relationships are formed, opportunities for spiritual discussion arise and confidence in salvation occurs.

180 HOUSE - Venice

Located in downtown Venice, not far from Venice High School, the

180 House offers teens, ages 11 to 18, a place to hang out with friends, have fun, and experience the love of Jesus. As an outreach of Suncoast Youth for Christ, the 180 House is intent on reaching youth who often feel unloved, unsafe and unseen. The 180 House is unique in that it uses board sports and the arts as a common interest to build




relationships and teach life skills, with the help of adult volunteers of all ages. Almost 30 High school and 35 middle school students attend Bible studies, faith-based camps, volunteer in the community, and learn to navigate life's challenges with adult mentors. Many students said yes to Christ this year. This year, Christ Venice Church will help to add an ADA bathroom in the garage.

Christ for Cuba works to establish sister church relationships to help Cuban pastors share the Gospel and improve lives in their communities. If a pastor does not have a sister church, then the pastor does not receive a salary, and more than 60 percent of Cuban pastors do not have a sister



church. Your Faith Promise dollars have helped provide these pastors and their churches with Bibles, cell phone minutes, a laptop, water purification systems, church repairs and expansions, and transportation in isolated areas.

The Coleman family moved from Haiti over two years ago to Moneague, Jamaica because of ongoing civil unres KONBIT - a term used to describe a group of people coming together to ac complish a project in their community itual and physical needs of its communities in se



cluding job creation, discipling, emergency housing, feeding programs, and much more. From Jamaica, they continue to serve people in Haiti with "Meals on 2 Wheels". It requires the assistance of armored military to deliver food to starving people. Konbit facilitated the provision of thousands of school supplies, Vacation Bible School, small construction projects for churches and a children's community area. Konbit helps churches to move the cause of the kingdom of God forward in their communities. *Rachael is the daughter of Christ Venice's very first pastor, Mike Shirley.*

Kevin was born and raised in Brazil and is passionate about helping to reach low-income youth with the Gospel of Jesus Christ through camp ministry. The free, weekend mini camps are held in the suburbs of

Sao Paulo in partnership with local churches and other organizations that also work with low-income youth. Campers play high-energy, competitive games, participate in meaningful skits and receive good meals - many times better than what they receive in their homes. The activities help to break down barriers to reach the minds and hearts of youth with the love of Jesus. The Gospel is presented with open discussions. At the end of camp, the youth are connected to the local churches for follow-up and discipleship.

ECHO GLOBAL FARM Ft. Myers, FL

For more than 30 years, ECHO has impacted millions of lives by teaching small-scale, sustainable farming to people around the world. ECHO's mission is to follow



Jesus by reducing hunger and improving lives worldwide through partnerships that equip people with agricultural resources and skills. Your Faith Promise dollars provided year-round financial support, as well as additional funds to help rebuild damaged facilities.

GIDEONS INTERNATIONAL - Lemon Bay Camp

For more than 120 years, The Gideons International has shared the Gospel through distribution of Bibles. In 2024, the local Gideons camp took part in 105 distribution events including those at the University of South Florida, the Sarasota County Fair, the Venice and Englewood Farmers Markets, the Awaken Food Bank in North Port, and the Gasparilla Inn & Club. The camp also distributes to local schools, hotels, doctor's offices, assisted living facilities, and more. They also distributed Bibles to children



attending Vacation Bible Schools and school-based Bible clubs. Last May alone, the local Gideons distributed over 12,000 Scriptures and are far exceeding that number today.

SMITH, Jerry & Susan CTW/ Lifeqwest

The Smiths' ministry has transitioned from "boots on the ground" to "senders and facilitators" as they now provide support, leadership and counseling to pastors and churches in Mongolia, Panama, Europe, Venezuela, India, Romania, North Af-



rica, Israel and in the U.S.. Based in Houston, TX, the Smiths use their experience to help bring resources and prayer to pastors. Today, God is allowing them to help national pastors and missionaries they know personally around the globe to raise the Banner of Jesus Christ, to "GO and make disciples of all nations." Christ Venice Faith Promise gifts have helped distribute 1,500 Bibles in Telugu, Hindi and Punjabi languages in various rural villages in India and sent relief supplies for Ukraine.

SHEETS, Jason & Sarah Peru TEAM (The Evangelical Alliance Mission)

The Sheets have served for more than 9 years in Arequipa, Peru. They are church planters in an area called "Ciudad de Dios". Jason serves as local pastor preaching, teaching, and discipling



the congregation. He also trains local people for work in the ministry. "We have a weekly Sunday service and Sunday school for the whole family and small groups and Christian education classes on Saturdays. We meet on Wednesday nights to pray together. God has used His Word to teach us, challenge us, grow us and correct us. We are thankful that His Word is truth!" Sarah works primarily with women's and children's ministry. They practice and teach 'one on one evangelism' and have outreach activities to hundreds in the community. In 2024, your Faith Promise gifts helped build a classroom for teens, a pastoral office and a nursery space.

DeLUCIA, Roberto & Anna Word of Life - Atibaia, Brazil

At the Vinde Meninos Relief Center in Atibaia, Sao Paulo, children and teens living in extreme poverty arrive after school each day for Bible lessons, tutoring, recreation and a healthy meal.



There are currently 116 children attending the after school program and more than 60 at the expansion locations. Six teens were baptized last year and more than 300 children and their families attended the annual Christmas celebration where the Gospel is shared and gifts are given. Roberto said 7 short-term mission teams came to Vinde Meninos in 2024 to minister to the children. "This is a great help for our staff, and the kids absolutely love having Americans visiting and playing with them," he said. Christ Venice sent an intergenerational team in 2016 and is to come again. Your Faith Promise gifts have provided significant property improvements and have helped expand programming.

EBNER, Johannes & Lena Calling Ministry/Liberia, Africa

As year-round partners with the Ebners, your Faith Promise dollars provide food, clothing, education, clean water, parenting classes, and so much more, to the



surrounding villages where the Ebners live. They also provide ongoing help to 11 families with special needs children, and last year they helped 15 children with severe medical needs and 10 children suffering from severe malnutrition. Your gifts also helped the Ebners build a Christian bush school (with outdoor bathrooms!) that now has 135 children ages pre-K to 2nd grade. These children have no other opportunity for an education. By meeting their physical and educational needs, the door is opened for the Ebners to develop relationships with neighbors and introduce them to Jesus.

EDMISTON, Pat & Melenda Wycliffe Bible Translators, Southeast Asia, New Guinea

Pat and Melenda have dedicated their lives to translating the Scriptures and teaching people to read and write in their native languages. Pat works with



various translation projects in the South Pacific, primarily in Papau New Guinea and the Solomon Islands. In May 2024, Pat's team completed checking the book of Leviticus for the Are'are people in the Solomon Islands. And in September, the Feni New Testament, which Pat consultant-checked, was dedicated on Anir Island, off the coast of New Ireland province, PNG. In October, Pat did the final check of the Buhutu New Testament and the team is in the process of preparing it for typesetting. In November, after working with Label translators for many years, the Label New Testament was dedicated. They have completed checking the last book (Romans) of the Notsi New Testament, which has been sent off to publishers, and the dedication is set for May of this year. In 2025, Pat will be checking Old Testament books for several language teams in the Solomon Islands. The couple also has plans to revisit the Alamblak people and attend the dedication of the reprint of the Alamblak New Testament, which Pat helped to successfully translate in previous years.

VICTOR, Pastor Fresnel Eglise Apocalypse - Rouge, Haiti

Pastor Fresnel is the son of Pastor Fan Fan, who passed away last year. He is now leading the ministry that Christ Venice began supporting more than 25 years ago. Christ Venice helped build and operate a rice mill, a church and a Christian school that



continues to serve the Haitian community. Fresnel reported "Despite the difficult situation that our country is going through on the economic, social and political front; we continue to bless the name of God for his faithfulness."

QUERFELD, Craig & Sue TEAM (The Evangelical Alliance Mission), Latin America

Craig and Sue Querfeld have served with TEAM (The Evangelical Alliance Mission) for over 30 years. Their primary ministry was church planting in Arequipa, Peru. Currentl Craig serves on the Latin America Leadershi



and supervises missionaries, rebuilding TEAM in South America. He works with TEAM's legacy partners—places where TEAM previously planted churches with ongoing ministry after missionaries moved on to address needs and support our Latin American brothers and sisters, working together to further the Kingdom of God. He is doing this through mentoring and creating connections between different TEAM-related ministries, with a vision to create a network of churches and Christian organizations who, when working together, will be able to plant churches throughout Latin America and send missionaries to other parts of the world.

RENEWED HOPE MISSIONS

Santiago, Dominican Republic Pastor Sairy Marte

Renewed Hope Missions has ministered to impoverished children and their families in Santiago and several neighboring communities including Cuesta Arena and Los Cocos for more than 10



years. Though the construction of buildings, schools and the distribution of clean water is an important focus of this ministry, the main goal is to share the love of God and offer hope for the future. Renewed Hope also provides a high-quality preschool and tutoring program for local children and about 30 children attend a new weekly Bible study. Christ Venice has sent a medical/dental short-term missions team to Renewed Hope for the past several years and will be returning in March 2025.

MOZLEY, Michael & Pam

Catalyst For The World (formerly for Africa)

Catalyst for the World is expanding its mission and work beyond Africa to the world. It is a leadership/discipleship development ministry previously serving in 15 different Afri-

can countries and partnering with more than 40 African leaders. CFW held four conferences and trained 50 leaders this past year. Michael holds weekly discipleship training with over 20 leaders monthly. This past year CFW participated in an 8-day conference in Malta, meeting with leaders from several North African countries and the Middle East, as well as a 10-year anniversary conference in Cotonou, Benin with 14 leaders from 10 different countries. CFW also visited with leaders in Ghana, Togo and Benin.

PROMISE FOR HAITI David Rueher

Promise for Haiti provides the best healthcare and education in Central Haiti. More than 145,000 people have been served through this ministry of healthcare, education, clean water, evangelism and community development. This



past year, your Faith Promise gifts helped fund three solar wells to provide clean water and combat the cholera epidemic that has plagued this area for many years. Your giving helped build one of nine Christian primary schools in the area surrounding Pignon. Each of the nine primary schools supported by Promise for Haiti provide meals for all the students, which may be the only meal the students have that day. David Ruehr, PFH is the grandson of John & Janet Outerbridge, founders of our church.

HALE, Ryan & Gina Axia International Sicily, Italy

The Hale family works with immigrants and refugees coming to Europe from Africa, the Middle East, and South Asia. Their church at Agape Bici has now multiplied and opened a new church. In Catania, they



are starting a new Spanish-speaking group for immigrants and refugees from various Latin American countries. They are also training other churches. An ex-Muslim from Bangladesh, whom they have trained, has launched 4 churches and is working to start a 5th in Rome amongst Afghans, Bangladeshi, Italians, and others. Our Pakistani teammates in northern Italy have started several groups. They have people planting churches in Tunisia, Mali, and Hungary. Agape Bici is going strong in Catania and has been adapted for ministry outreach in several refugee camps in northern Italy. Our team's community garden is partnering with Italian churches as well as immigrants from Mauritius and Argentina. Faith Promise gifts support the Hales year-round and have helped expand the ministry. *Ryan's parents, Steve and Dianna Hale, attend Christ Venice.*

JEAN-GILLES, Julio Cap Haitien, Haiti

Pastor Julio and his wife, Guermanie, oversee Bethesda Church in the Madeline neighborhood of Cap Haitien, serving about 500 parishioners, as well as overseeing a primary school that serves close



to 200 children. There is no free education in Haiti so most families cannot afford to send their children to school. This ministry partners with others to help cover the cost of schooling for impoverished children and helps families become self-sustaining through growing their own food, as well as providing clean water to those in the community. Political and civil unrest is causing great hardships for the people of Haiti. Gangs have been terrorizing the area where Pastor Julio serves and there is much lawlessness, which cost the life of his son.

KHALIL, Fawzi Egypt YWAM (Youth With A Mission)

With war on every side, Fawzi continues to travel throughout the devasted and dangerous area in order to present the Gospel to Palestinians, Sudanese and Syrians. They visit



105 families every week with food and blankets. In January they delivered the last of the blankets and have asked for help to get more. Many are women and children whose husbands/fathers were killed in the fighting. They often live without cover and winter has come. Fawzi leads a healing ministry and reports a woman who came unable to straighten her back when she walked came for prayer. A short time later she returned, walking upright to show them that God had healed her. Christ Venice giving has sent blankets, medicine and other relief supplies as well as provided housing for those with no cover in the cold winter.

MUSTAFAJ, Luli & Hannah Albania Teach Beyond & World Gospel Mission

Luli and Hannah, whose father was a former pastor in Venice, live and minister in the village of Vlashaj, where Luli grew up. Luli became a Christian through the ministry of YWAM and, at the



age of 15, began reading the Bible and translating it for his people. Today, he still translates for other missionaries. Hannah teaches fifth grade at GDQ International Christian School outside the capital city of Tirana. Together, they lead an Alpha class for teenagers, a Kids Club, and oversee other outreach programs in the village. Luli coaches a futbol team and does physical training for adults with disabilities. Albania is a declared atheist country that was Communist until the nineties. Today, many in south Albania identify as Christian, and in the north as historical Muslims but most are nonpracticing. Their mission is to bring the Albanian people to Christ.

MILLER, Harry (Hank), Deby & Asher One Middle East Agency (OMEA)

When the Millers started their congregation in northern Israel in 2021 there were 15 members. Today, there are more than 40, including eight children ages 2-8. The war has directed their efforts to bring Christ to the people through humanitarian aid. They minister daily to new immigrants, Arabic, Druze, Russian, Ukrainian, Argentinean and Brazilian families.



They purchased 3 bomb shelters to hold 60 people, traveled treacherous roads to take food and water to reserve duty soldiers and helped hundreds of families to have food. They started a podcast and an online Hebrew school for immigrants. Three students, Cuban and Argentinean, have given their lives to Christ. They are raising money for a church building with a humanitarian aid wing, classrooms and a daycare center.

MOTAKATLA, Pastor Daniel New Covenant Ministry - India

This past summer there were heavy rains and floods and hundreds of people were drowned and washed away. Many peo-



ple are suffering with viral illnesses from the stagnated water left behind. "Still we are doing well, by the grace of God" reported Pastor Daniel. The ministry travels to different villages, where five people accepted Christ through water baptism. They handed out 5 goats to needy families, gave a leg peddled sewing machine to the pastor's wife. Once a year all the elderly get new cloths from our ministry and the NCM's pastors also got their new cloths as Christmas gifts. We had a 3 day fasting prayers, where all the pastors gather and on the third day, we had baptisms followed by the ordination of my son Samuel.
