Day 1—Wednesday, March 5

Psalm 51:1-2 Have mercy on me O God, because of Your unfailing love. Because of Your great compassion, blot out the stain of my sins. Wash me clean from my guilt. Purify me from my sin.

Prayer Prompt: Confess your sins to God and ask for His mercy and forgiveness, trusting in His unfailing love and compassion.

Day 2—Thursday, March 6

1 John 1:9 But if we confess our sins to Him, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.

Prayer Prompt: Confess your sins to God and thank Him for His faithfulness and justice in forgiving you and cleansing you from unrighteousness.

Day 3—Friday, March 7

Isaiah 1:18 "Come now, let us settle the matter," says the LORD. "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool."

Prayer Prompt: Ask God to make you white as snow and cleanse you from all sin, recognizing His power to forgive and restore.

Day 4—Saturday, March 8

Luke 15:10 In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents.

Prayer Prompt: Confess your sins to God and thank Him for His faithfulness and justice in forgiving you and cleansing you from unrighteousness.

Day 30—Tuesday, April 8

Ephesians 4:32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for a compassionate heart that is quick to forgive others, as God in Christ forgave you.

Day 31—Wednesday, April 9

Colossians 1:13-14 For He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Prayer Prompt: Thank God for delivering you from the domain of darkness and transferring you to the Kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom you have redemption and the forgiveness of sins.

Day 32—Thursday, April 10

Hebrews 12:1-2 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before Him, He endured the cross scorning its shame and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Prayer Prompt: Fix your eyes on Jesus the author and perfecter of your faith, lay aside every weight and sin that hinders your relationship with Him.

Day 33—Friday, April 11

Matthew 26:28 This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

Prayer Prompt: Thank Jesus for the forgiveness of sins through His blood, and commit to living in the freedom and grace of His covenant.

Day 34—Friday, April 12

Psalm 51:10 Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Prayer Prompt: Ask God to create a clean heart and renew a steadfast spirit within you, allowing you to walk in righteousness and truth.

Day 11—Monday, March 17

James 4:8 Come near to God and He will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

Prayer Prompt: Ask God to draw near to you as you draw near to Him, purifying your heart and cleansing your hands.

Day 12—Tuesday, March 18

Matthew 6:14-15 For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for the grace to forgive others as God has forgiven you, recognizing the importance of extending mercy to receive mercy.

Day 13—Wednesday, March 19

Psalm 86:5 You, Lord, are forgiving and good, abounding in love to all who call to You.

Prayer Prompt: Praise God for His forgiveness and love, and call upon Him in times of need, knowing that He hears and answers.

Day 14—Thursday, March 20

Luke 17:3-4 So watch yourselves. "If your brother or sister sins against you, rebuke them; and if they repent, forgive them. Even if they sin against you seven times in a day and seven times come back to you saying 'I repent,' you must forgive them."

Prayer Prompt: Ask God to help you forgive others as you have been forgiven, seeking reconciliation and peace in your relationships.

Day 15—Friday, March 21

Colossians 3:13 Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for the strength to bear with others and forgive as Christ forgave you, reflecting His grace and mercy in your interactions.

Day 16—Saturday, March 22

Mark 1:15 "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!"

Prayer Prompt: Repent and believe in the good news of Jesus Christ, asking for the grace to turn away from sin and embrace the Kingdom of God.
