DAILY PRAYER PROMPTS

Day 5—Monday, March 10

Acts 3:19 Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord

Prayer Prompt: Pray for the grace to repent and turn to God, seeking refreshment and restoration in His presence.

Day 6—Tuesday, March 11

Matthew 3:8 Produce fruit in keeping with repentance.

Prayer Prompt: Ask God to help you produce fruit in keeping with repentance and to transform your heart and actions.

Day 7—Wednesday, March 12

Psalm 32:5 Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD." And You forgave the guilt of my sin.

Prayer Prompt: Acknowledge your sins before God and seek His forgiveness, knowing that He will cleanse you and remove your guilt.

Day 8—Thursday, March 13

2 Chronicles 7:14 if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for humility, repentance, and healing in your life and in your community, seeking God's forgiveness and restoration.

Day 9—Friday, March 14

Ezekiel 18:30 Therefore, you Israelites, I will judge each of you according to your own ways, declares the Sovereign LORD. Repent! Turn away from all your offenses; then sin will not be your downfall.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for a spirit of repentance and a turning away from sin, trusting in God's mercy and forgiveness.

Day 10—Saturday, March 15

Proverbs 28:13 Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy.

Prayer Prompt: Confess your sins to God and ask for His mercy and forgiveness, understanding that true prosperity comes from acknowledging and renouncing sin.

Day 35—Monday, April 14

Psalm 130:3-4 If you, LORD, kept a record of sins, Lord, who could stand? But with you there is forgiveness, so that we can, with reverence, serve you.

Prayer Prompt: Cry out to God from the depths of your soul, seeking mercy and forgiveness, and trusting in His redemptive power.

Day 36—Tuesday, April 15

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Prayer Prompt: Acknowledge the gift of God, which is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord, and express gratitude for His salvation and forgiveness.

Day 37—Wednesday, April 16

2 Corinthians 7:10 Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for godly grief that leads to repentance without regret, turning away from sin and embracing the forgiveness and restoration found in Christ.

Day 38—Thursday, April 17

Psalm 86:6-7 Hear my prayer, LORD; listen to my cry for mercy. When I am in distress, I call to You, because you answer me.

Prayer Prompt: Entreat God to give ear to your prayer, listen to your pleas for mercy, and grant you grace and strength to walk in His ways.

Day 39—Friday, April 18

Isaiah 43:25 "I, even I, am he who blots out your transgressions, for my own sake, and remembers your sins no more."

Prayer Prompt: Praise God for blotting out your transgressions, remembering your sins no more, and ask for the ability to forgive yourself as He has forgiven you.

Day 40—Saturday, April 19

1 Peter 2:24 "He Himself bore our sins" in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; "by His wounds you have been healed."

Prayer Prompt: Thank Jesus for bearing your sins in His body on the cross, that you might die to sin and live to righteousness, by His wounds receiving healing and restoration.

Day 29—Monday, April 7

Proverbs 28:14 Blessed is the one who always trembles before God, but whoever hardens their heart falls into trouble.

Prayer Prompt: Ask God for a heart that trembles before Him and a spirit that remains soft and open to his leading.

Day 30—Tuesday, April 8

Ephesians 4:32 Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for a compassionate heart that is quick to forgive others, as God in Christ forgave you.

Day 31—Wednesday, April 9

Colossians 1:13-14 For He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son He loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins.

Prayer Prompt: Thank God for delivering you from the domain of darkness and transferring you to the Kingdom of His beloved Son, in whom you have redemption and the forgiveness of sins.

Day 32—Thursday, April 10

Hebrews 12:1-2 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith. For the joy set before Him, He endured the cross scorning its shame and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.

Prayer Prompt: Fix your eyes on Jesus the author and perfecter of your faith, lay aside every weight and sin that hinders your relationship with Him.

Day 33—Friday, April 11

Matthew 26:28 This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

Prayer Prompt: Thank Jesus for the forgiveness of sins through His blood, and commit to living in the freedom and grace of His covenant.

Day 34—Friday, April 12

Psalms 51:10 Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Prayer Prompt: Ask God to create a clean heart and renew a steadfast spirit within you, allowing you to walk in righteousness and truth.

Day 11—Monday, March 17

James 4:8 Come near to God and He will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

Prayer Prompt: Ask God to draw near to you as you draw near to Him, purifying your heart and cleansing your hands.

Day 12—Tuesday, March 18

Matthew 6:14-15 For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for the grace to forgive others as God has forgiven you, recognizing the importance of extending mercy to receive mercy.

Day 13—Wednesday, March 19

Psalms 86:5 You, Lord, are forgiving and good, abounding in love to all who call to You.

Prayer Prompt: Praise God for His forgiveness and love, and call upon Him in times of need, knowing that He hears and answers.

Day 14—Thursday, March 20

Luke 17:3-4 So watch yourselves. "If your brother or sister sins against you, rebuke them; and if they repent, forgive them. Even if they sin against you seven times in a day and seven times come back to you saying 'I repent,' you must forgive them."

Prayer Prompt: Ask God to help you forgive others as you have been forgiven, seeking reconciliation and peace in your relationships.

Day 15—Friday, March 21

Colossians 3:13 Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for the strength to bear with others and forgive as Christ forgave you, reflecting His grace and mercy in your interactions.

Day 16—Saturday, March 22

Mark 1:15 "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!"

Prayer Prompt: Repent and believe in the good news of Jesus Christ, asking for the grace to turn away from sin and embrace the Kingdom of God.

Day 17—Monday, March 24

Acts 2:38 Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for repentance, baptism, and the forgiveness of sins, inviting the Holy Spirit to guide and empower you.

Day 18—Tuesday, March 25

Revelation 3:19 Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest and repent.

Prayer Prompt: Ask God for the humility to accept His discipline and the grace to repent and turn back to Him.

Day 19—Wednesday, March 26

Acts 17:30 In the past God overlooked such ignorance, but now He commands all people everywhere to repent.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for the wisdom to repent of ignorance and turn to God, seeking His forgiveness and guidance.

Day 20—Thursday, March 27

Psalms 103:12 as far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us.

Prayer Prompt: Thank God for removing your sins as far as the east is from the west, and ask for His continued mercy and grace.

Day 21—Friday, March 28

Colossians 3:16 Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

Prayer Prompt: Pray for the message of Christ to dwell richly in you, teaching and admonishing with wisdom and gratitude in your hearts.

Day 22—Saturday, March 29

1 Peter 5:6-7 Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that He may lift you up in due time. Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you.

Prayer Prompt: Humbly cast your anxieties on God, trusting in His care and provision for you.

Day 23—Monday, March 31

Matthew 11:28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest."

Prayer Prompt: Come to Jesus in weariness and find rest in His presence, pouring out your burdens to Him.

Day 24—Tuesday, April 1

Romans 2:4 Or do you show contempt for the riches of His kindness, forbearance and patience, not realizing that God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance?

Prayer Prompt: Ask God to lead you to repentance through His kindness, forbearance, and patience.

Day 25—Wednesday, April 2

Luke 24:46-47 He told them, "This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and repentance for the forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

Prayer Prompt: Thank God for the forgiveness of sins through the sacrifice of Christ, and pray for the message of repentance to be preached to all nations.

Day 26—Thursday, April 3

1 John 1:8 If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.

Prayer Prompt: Confess any areas of self-deception or sin to God, asking for His truth and light to guide you.

Day 27—Friday, April 4

Romans 10:9 If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Prayer Prompt: Declare Jesus as Lord and thank God for the salvation and forgiveness found in Him.

Day 28—Saturday, April 5

Psalms 32:1-2 Blessed is the one whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered. Blessed is the one whose sin the LORD does not count against them and in whose spirit is no deceit.

Prayer Prompt: Praise God for the blessing of forgiveness and righteousness, confessing any deceit in your spirit.
