Week 7: Is Jesus Coming Back?

In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again
- John 14:2-3 (ESV)

What are the differences in circumstances between Jesus' first and second coming?

When Jesus came the first time, it happened slowly.

When Jesus comes again, it will happen quickly.

It will happen in a moment. In the twinkling of an eye. - 1 Corinthians 15:52

When Jesus came the first time, it was announced.

Unto you is born this day a Savior, who is Christ the Lord - Luke 2:11

When Jesus comes again, He will come without warning

The day of the Lord's return will come unexpectedly - 1 Thessalonians 5:2

When Jesus came the first time, it was quiet

"Silent Night...all is calm..."

When Jesus comes again, it will be loud

The Lord Himself will come down from heaven with a commanding shout - 1 Thessalonians 4:16

When Jesus came the first time, it was bright

We saw His star in the east. - Matthew 2:2

When Jesus comes again, it will be BRIGHT

As the lightning comes from the east and flashes to the west, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be. - Matthew 24:27

When Jesus came the first time, He was alone

Going into the house, they saw the child... - Matthew 2:11

When Jesus comes again, He is bringing His angels

When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him - Matthew 25:31

When Jesus came the first time, only a few honored Him

He came to his own people, and even they rejected him. -

John 1:11

When Jesus comes again, everyone will honor Him.

Every knee will bow before Me - Romans 4:11

What are the differences in purposes between Jesus' first and second coming?

When Jesus came the first time, He came to save

For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn it, but to save it - John 3:17

When Jesus comes again, He is coming to judge

God has set a day when the entire human race will be judged with justice. - Acts 17:31

When Jesus came the first time, He came to die for our sins

God's unchanging plan has always been to adopt us into His own family by sending Jesus Christ to die for us. - Ephesians 1:5

When Jesus comes again, He is coming to gather His family

He will send His angels all around the earth and they will gather His chosen ones from every part of the world. - Matthew 24:31

When Jesus came the first time, He came in humility

When he appeared in human form, he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross. - Philippians 2:8

When Jesus comes again, He is coming in Glory
